Don't Assume Public Domain

= songs that are NOT restricted by copyright and do not require a license or fee for their use.

Enter Public Domain:

- 1. Creator abdicated their rights when song was created.
- 2. © has expired based on standards of a country where © was initially established.

Public Domain

In US, copyright is extended for the life of the composer's life, + 70 years.

Assume a piece is under copyright unless you have proof it is in the Public Domain.
