READ OUT LOUD FROM THE GOSPEL OF MATTHEW 17:1-9

Jesus took with him Peter and James and his brother John and led them up a high mountain, by themselves.

And he was transfigured before them, and his face shone like the sun, and his clothes became dazzling white.

Suddenly there appeared to them Moses and Elijah, talking with him.

Then Peter said to Jesus,

While he was still speaking, suddenly a bright cloud overshadowed them, and from the cloud a voice said,
